A PCA student bringing a guest to a PCA dance must abide by the following regulations:

- PCA student must enter and leave with the guest.
- PCA student is responsible for the behavior and demeanor of the guest.
- PCA student is responsible for informing guests of all PCA behavior and dress code rules.
- Each pass is verified for accuracy. Any forged signatures will result in forfeiture of dance attendance by PCA student and guest. The PCA student may also receive disciplinary action.

All PCA students and GUESTS must abide by the following regulations:

- Students and guests MUST have a current identification card to be admitted.
- Students and guests shall remain safe; therefore, slam dancing, crowd surfing, and moshing are prohibited.
- Students and guests shall dance in an appropriate manner; therefore, lewd and vulgar dancing is prohibited. This includes freak dancing and grinding. Students may not have front to back contact. With exception of feet, no body parts may be placed on the floor.
- Students and guests shall dress appropriately according to the theme of the dance, and school dress code will be enforced.
- Possessing drugs, alcohol, or tobacco or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol is prohibited.
- Students and guests aiding in sneaking a person into the dance shall be subject to the same penalty as the offender.
- When a student or guest leaves the dance, he/she may not return to the dance. Students and guests must leave immediately after the dance is over.
- Students or guests who violate any of these rules will be removed from the dance. Parents will be notified. Violations may exclude a student and guest from future dances.

All GUESTS must abide by the following regulations:

- I will treat all school personnel and chaperones with respect and will conform to all rules and regulations.
- I recognize that my date is responsible for my behavior at the dance and that consequences for my actions can fall upon him/her.
